



No Compromise by Melody Green (Biography)

A spiritual revolutionary, he found freedom through Jesus, not religion, and spent his last years convincing others to refuse to accept the status quo and instead to bring compassion and honesty back to the church.




Chasing the Dragon by Jackie Pullinger (Biography)

Inside Hong Kong was the infamous Walled City. It was a haven of filth, crime, and sin. Prostitution, pornography, and drug addiction flourished. Jackie Pullinger was twenty years old when God called her to the Walled City. As she spoke of Jesus Christ, brutal hoods were converted, prostitutes retired from their trade, and heroin junkies found new power that freed them from the bondage of drug addiction. Hundreds discovered new life in Christ.



The Hiding Place by Corrie Ten Boom (Biography)

Corrie ten Boom was a Dutch watchmaker who became a heroine of the Resistance, a survivor of Hitler's concentration camps, and one of the most remarkable evangelists of the twentieth century. In World War II she and her family risked their lives to help Jews and underground workers escape from the Nazis, and for their work they were tested in the infamous Nazi death camps. Only Corrie among her family survived to tell the story of how faith ultimately triumphs over evil.




Amazing Grace by Eric Metaxas (Biography)

Amazing Grace tells the story of the remarkable life of the British abolitionist William Wilberforce (1759-1833) chronicling his extraordinary role as a human rights activist, cultural reformer, and member of Parliament.



Secrets of the Secret Place by Bob Sorge (Christian Life)



Loving God by Charles Colson (Christian Life)


