GLIT OR GRIT? A CHRISTMAS FOR ALL?

- o The Pre-emptive Strike Rule: Do to others what you think they are going to do to you. X
- "If you love those who love you what credit is that to you? Even sinners love those who love them. And if you did good to those who did good to you, what credit is that to you? Even sinners do that. And if you lend to those from whom you expect repayment, what credit is that to you? Even sinners lend expecting to be repaid in full. But love your enemies and do good to them."
